Lecturer (Collaborative Contracts) (Part-time)

The applicant must possess

- (1) a recognised degree in building / architectural studies or structural / mechanical or other construction-related disciplines;
- (2) a minimum of 7 years post-qualification relevant working experience in local construction projects; in-depth knowledge and hands-on practice on collaborative contracts are needed; teaching experience will be a definite advantage;
- (3) knowledge in relevant codes / practice notes / guidelines in architectural / structural areas or mechanical / electrical and plumbing (MEP) areas is preferred;
- (4) self-driven character to pursue continuing education;
- (5) ability to work independently and be a team player;
- (6) knowledge on Microsoft application software (including Word, Excel and PowerPoint, etc.); and
- (7) excellent command of both written and spoken English and Cantonese.

(Applicants who do not possess the required qualifications and / or experience may be considered for other positions within the organisation.)

Duties include

- (1) to conduct the introduction course and the courses for experienced and advanced users of the collaborative contracts, as well as to carry out assessment duties;
- (2) to participate in training programmes and curriculum development;
- (3) to prepare training course materials;
- (4) to assist the execution of training initiatives;

- (5) to undertake appropriate administrative responsibility; and
- (6) to carry out any other duties as assigned from time to time by the Executive Director.
