2. To identify emerging policy issues that may affect construction industry and lead the development of a strategic and organized communications approach for advocating CIC's positions;
3. To serve as the primary point of contact for co-ordinating issues related to the B&C;
4. To develop benchmark with a view to analysing and assessing the performance of the industry against international best practices for continuous development and improvement of the industry;
5. To manage and develop strategies to ensure the key objectives of decisions from the B&C are achieved;
6. To monitor and track operational progress against performance goals of individual tasks assigned by the B&C and prepare reports for discussions at the CIC Council;
7. To provide support and advice to Council Members on issues related to construction industry development; and
8. To carry out any other duties as assigned by the Executive Director from time to time.

Requirements

The incumbent must possess:

1. A recognized degree, preferably with post-graduate and/or professional qualifications in the field of engineering/ surveying/ architecture or construction related disciplines from an accredited institution;
2. A minimum of 18 years' solid experience in the field of engineering, architecture, surveying, or any construction related discipline, preferably with proven record in managing construction projects and in advocating construction best practices;
3. Strong commitment towards the advancement of the construction industry in Hong Kong with sound knowledge of local construction practices;
4. Good networking capabilities and be able to establish strong working relationships with government officials, industry practitioners and key stakeholders;
5. Strong knowledge of the construction industry development;
6. A high degree of competence in project management, detailed-minded and result-oriented;
7. Exceptional strong in interpersonal and communication skills and strong network with local and overseas industry stakeholders; and
8. Excellent command of both written and spoken English and Chinese.
