The applicant must possess

- (1) a recognized degree, preferably in marketing and business management related disciplines;
- (2) a minimum of 7 years post-qualification work experience in partnership management or business development;
- (3) excellent communication, interpersonal and problem solving skills;
- (4) a mindset to be mature, analytical, flexible; and able to work independently and under pressure;
- (5) a self-starting personality with entrepreneurial spirit;
- (6) good written and spoken presentation skills;
- (7) excellent command of both written and spoken English and Chinese is a must; and
- (8) ability to articulate vision persuasively and to engage different stakeholders of diverse backgrounds successfully.

(Applicants who do not possess the required qualifications and / or experience may be considered for other positions within the organisation.)

Duties include

The incumbent is expected to:

- (1) plan, identify, establish and manage new partnership programmes that can enrich ZCB's exhibition contents, increase venue utilization and drive incremental visitation;
- (2) be the core member in completing the partnership formation process and execution including invitation exercises, design discussion, agreement drafting and implementation;
- (3) manage the partner and exhibitor relationships and drive win-win decisions;
- (4) drive annual goals against the annual targets such as the annual thematic exhibitions, venue rental income and number of visitors;
- (5) explore, design and implement new initiatives and elements that can enhance the visitor experiences at ZCB including the services of the self-guided and guided tours;
- (6) plan and control the budget in relation to relevant projects;
- (7) be an effective writer in preparing project documentations including drafting of invitations, tender briefs, tender recommendations, reports and presentations;
- (8) work closely with the Services Delivery & Outreach and other teams at ZCB and the Construction Industry Council (CIC); and
- (9) carry out any other duties as assigned from time to time by the Executive Director.
