The CIC is looking for a highly talented individual to fill the position of:

Associate Librarian

The applicant must possess

- (1) a recognised degree and professional qualifications in librarianship (MLS or equivalent);
- (2) a minimum of 7 years' library work experience, amongst which no less than 4 years at supervisory level with implementation experience of e-library at college / tertiary education;
- (3) working knowledge in the development of Learning Resource Centre, including physical set up, book acquisition, cataloguing system, circulation system, etc.;
- (4) knowledge of library professional trends, theories and best practices for the delivery of updated and innovative user services;
- (5) experience in system development of Library System and ability to lead the System Services to provide a wide range of quality services;
- (6) the ability to work independently and a good team player;
- (7) excellent planning, analytical, interpersonal skills; and
- (8) good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese.

(Applicants who do not possess the required qualifications and / or experience may be considered for other positions within the organisation.)

Duties include

- (1) to act as the key member of the Library setup for the Hong Kong Institute of Construction (HKIC) from inception to put into action;
- (2) to lead, develop and implement the Library System, set priorities and programme plan;
- (3) to lead, manage, co-ordinate and monitor the day-to-day operation of the libraries located

- at various campuses of the HKIC;
- (4) to lead and advise on the development of innovative service models and programmes for fostering user experiences;
- (5) to ensure implementation of the Guidelines, Policies and Procedures;
- (6) to develop Library Operation in areas of digital library application, research services, technology, digital services, multi-media / e-learning, language centres, etc.;
- (7) to provide timely reports and statistical analysis to support decision making; and
- (8) to carry out any other duties as assigned from time to time by the Executive Director.

The position is on a renewable fixed-term contract (subject to performance and operational needs) for a period of 2 years.
