The CIC is looking for a highly talented individual to fill the position of:

Assistant Manager – Career Support Services

The applicant must possess

- (1) a recognised degree in social work, counseling, marketing, communication, business administration or other related disciplines;
- (2) a minimum of 7 years' post-qualification work experience, preferably in sizeable organisations / education institutions / government departments;
- (3) proficiency in Microsoft applications and Chinese word processing;
- (4) excellent project management and interpersonal skills;
- (5) good time management skills and ability to work independently under pressure; and
- (6) good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese.

(Applicants who do not possess the required qualifications and / or experience may be considered for other positions within the organisation.)

Duties include

- (1) to monitor the placement exercise of graduates of training courses;
- (2) to liaise with prospective employers and to monitor the continuous employment of graduates;
- (3) to develop Apprenticeship for Basic Craft Course and Construction Diploma Programme students:
- (4) to oversee organisation of career talks, job fairs, interview skill and work motivation workshops, site visits and other career-related activities for students;
- (5) to monitor Mentorship Programme and Contractors Sponsorship Scheme;
- (6) to develop alumni activities and enhance communication with alumni;

- (7) to organise annual events such as Graduation Ceremony, Alumni Lo Pan Dinner and Employers Appreciation Ceremony; and
- (8) to carry out any other duties as assigned from time to time by the Executive Director.

The position is on a renewable fixed-term contract (subject to performance and operational needs) for a period of 2 years.
