

The Construction Industry Council (CIC) was formed on 1 February 2007 under the Construction Industry Council Ordinance (Cap. 587). Our Mission is to strengthen the sustainability of the construction industry in Hong Kong by providing a communication platform, striving for continuous improvement, increasing awareness of health and safety, as well as improving skills development.



The CIC is looking for a highly talented individual to fill the position of:

Lecturer – Building Information Modelling (BIM)

The applicant must possess

- (1) a recognised degree in building / architectural studies or structural / mechanical / electrical engineering / quantity surveying, or other construction-related discipline; holders of higher diploma / diploma will also be considered;
- (2) a minimum of 7 years' post-qualification work experience in local construction projects;
- (3) knowledge in relevant codes / practice notes / guidelines in architectural / structural areas or mechanical / electrical and plumbing (MEP) areas is preferred; practical experience in BIM is highly preferred; teaching experience will be a definite advantage;
- (4) competency in using BIM solutions such as Bentley / Graphisoft / Revit;
- (5) self-driven character to pursue continuing education on BIM;
- (6) ability to work independently with minimal guidance as a team player;
- (7) knowledge on Microsoft application software (including Word, Excel, PowerPoint. etc.); and
- (8) good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese.

(Applicants who do not possess the required qualifications and / or experience may be considered for other positions within the organisation.)

Duties include

- (1) to formulate training strategies, implementation plan and qualification ladder for meeting the needs of Hong Kong Architecture, Engineering and Construction (AEC) industry practitioners, both professionals and technical people;
- (2) to review existing curriculum / courses and develop new BIM training courses and materials;
- (3) to conduct teaching on BIM courses and carry out assessment duties;

- (4) to identify and coordinate with subject experts in organising short courses, workshops and seminars on specialised BIM applications to meet the increasing needs of the industry;
- (5) to work with academia in development of BIM training for undergraduates;
- (6) to conduct survey of BIM training offered in Hong Kong;
- (7) to support the established Task Force on BIM Training; and
- (8) to carry out any other duties as assigned from time to time by the Executive Director.

Applications

The position is on a renewable fixed-term contract (subject to performance and operational needs) for a period of 2 years.
