## The applicant must possess

- (1) Level 2 or above in 5 subjects including English and Chinese in the HKDSE; or Grade E or above in 5 subjects including English and Chinese in the HKCEE; or equivalent;
- (2) a minimum of 3 years' post-qualification work experience, preferably in administrative work and customer services;
- (3) a high level of integrity and a good sense of responsibility;
- (4) proactive character, customer-oriented mindset and team spirit;
- (5) good communication, project coordination and interpersonal skills; and
- (6) proficiency in Microsoft application software (including Word, Excel and PowerPoint, etc.) and Chinese word processing.

(Applicants who do not possess the required qualifications and / or experience may be considered for other positions within the organisation.)

## **Duties include**

- (1) to assist in the daily operations of the CIC Aberdeen Trade Testing Centre including but not limited to answering enquiries, handling applications and assisting in the promotion of the CIC's services;
- (2) to act as the ambassador of the centre to serve visitors and answer enquiries in good manners;
