Sub-contractor Cooperative Training Scheme Recruitment Day

Hong Kong • 11 April 2013 – The “Sub-contractor Cooperative Training Scheme Recruitment Day” is jointly organized by Construction Industry Council and Hong Kong Construction Sub-Contractors Association. The purpose of the event is to recruit 500 new entrants as a start to join the construction industry by the newly launched “Sub-contractor Cooperative Training Scheme”. The highlight of the scheme is, by means of giving a provisional offer of employment before training, trainees can receive on monthly basis an income at HK\$12,000 during the course of on-site training. Apart from that, the whole scheme would last for 24 months, a long-term engagement that covers both training and employment.

The Recruitment Day will be held on 13 April (Saturday) 10:00am to 5:00pm at Construction Industry Resources Centre, 44 Tai Yip Street, Kowloon Bay. The job vacancies comprise the following trades: Bricklayer, Tiler, Plasterer, Marble Worker, Painter, Tower Crane Erecting & Dismantling Worker, Carpenter, Bar Bender and Fixer as well as Scaffolder. The trade association of respective trade will set up recruitment counters and conduct selection interview instantly.

Successful applicants will receive fundamental skill training in Construction Industry Council or a designated training institution before attending on-site training. Upon the completion of training, trainees will be assigned for relevant trade test to ascertain the level of their skills.
