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

Workers Registration Office will contact the applicants after they pass the certification test for following up the registration matters.

Guides to Applicants

- The test fees listed may be reviewed and adjusted by the CIC if necessary without prior notice.
- According to the "Code of Practice for Safe Use and Operation of Suspended Working Platforms" issued by the Labour Department, every person operating the suspended working platform should be fit, agile and not be height phobic.
- Applicants for Re-validation Course for Operators of Builder's Lift must have been frequently operating builders' lifts over the last five years. Applicants can apply for revalidation within 6 months prior to or within 6 months after the expiry of their current certification cards. Application for revalidation submitted more than 6 months prior to the expiry date will not be entertained and later than the 6 months grace period will be treated as new application.
- Applicants who are not Hong Kong Permanent Residents, please attach the copy of valid working permit issued by the Hong Kong Immigration Department.
- Applicants who reach the age of 65, please call Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre 2100 9000 for checking
 the trades that may be required to submit medical examination reports issued by Registered Medical Practitioners and acquiring
 the standard forms of reports.
- Applicant may request for postponement of safety training by submitting his/her reasons in writing. Such letter must reach CIC
 <u>at least 3 working days</u> before the scheduled training day. If the reason is accepted by the HKCITTC, the applicant can
 reschedule 1 time for free.
- CIC reserves all rights to amend trade test arrangement, including but not limited to accept any test/ course application and/ or change the relevant clauses in a timely manner without giving any reasons or explanations, and CIC will not accept any liability in respect of claims for expenses or other damages.
- Notice for candidates:
 - (1) Candidates must show their <u>valid Construction Industry Safety Training Certificate (Green Card)</u> and wear suitable work wear including safety shoes; otherwise, you will not be able to attend the practical test and be treated as an absence.



- (2) Candidates who are absent from any half-day class for more than 15 minutes, would be disqualified.
- Application
 - (1) Applicants can enroll via the mobile application ("TTOA"). Upon approval of application, the applicants could settle the related payment via ATM / by Cheque / by bank transfer OR at 7-Eleven by presenting the barcode given in the TTOA;
 - (2) Complete the application form together with a cheque or bank draft for the test fee payable to "Construction Industry Council":
 - (3) A <u>photocopy</u> of the applicant's <u>Hong Kong ID Card and "Construction Industry Safety Training Course Certificate" (Green Card)</u> must be affixed on the application form;
 - (4) Send the completed application form, supporting document (Point 3 of above) and together with a cheque or bank draft to the Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre, 38/F, COS Centre, 56 Tsun Yip Street Kwun Tong, Kowloon;
 - (5) All trade test fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Candidates who want to withdraw from the tests have to submit their reasons in writing to the CIC at least 3 working days before the schedule test date. An administration fee amounting to 20% of the paid test fee will be charged. Special consideration will be given to candidates who request to withdraw because of prolonged injury.

Mandatory Safety Training Courses Notes for Trainees

Content of Mandatory Safety Training Courses

For assuring the quality of mandatory safety training courses, all training course providers are required to offer courses according to the relevant course contents as stipulated in the 《Guidance Notes on Application for Recognition of Mandatory Safety Training Courses》 and the 《Approval Conditions for Operating Mandatory Safety Training Courses》.

Central Issuance of Examination Papers by Labour Department

Examination papers for the mandatory safety training courses are generated on random selection basis from examination questions prepared by the Labour Department. They will be issued centrally to training course providers at the specified time soon before the examination. This examination arrangement is applicable to the following mandatory safety training courses:

- Mandatory Basic Safety Training Course for Employees in the Construction Industry*
- Safety Training Course for Certified Workers of Confined Spaces Operation*
- Training Course for Persons Working on Suspended Working Platforms*
- Standardised Part of Course Content of Training for Operators of Crane *
- Mandatory Basic Safety Training Course for Employees in the Container Handling Industry*
- Safety Training Course for Competent Persons of Confined Spaces Operation**
- Gas Welding Safety Training Course*
- Standardised Part of Course Content of Training for Operators of Loadshifting Machine *

(*Including revalidation course) (**Including revalidation course and top-up course)

Course Arrangements and Requirements

A trainee may make any queries to the training course provider on the course arrangements, including teaching language, health condition requirements, appropriate dressing, arrangements in times of inclement weather, absence, attendance requirements, class rules, visual and audio recording and etc.

Visual and Audio Recording

The training course provider shall make visual and audio recording during the following sections of the course:

- written examinations, including distribution and marking of examination papers in examination venue
- hands-on practice on the use of safety harness with lifeline and fall arresting device
- hands-on practice on the use of approved breathing apparatus

Attendance

Any trainee who is absent from the class for more than 15 minutes for any half-day sessions (applicable to theory session only) will be disqualified to attend the examination.

Online Learning Kit

The Labour Department has prepared a set of online learning kit. The content of learning kit covers all parts of two categories of courses (i.e. Mandatory Safety Training Course for Employees in the Construction Industry and Mandatory Safety Training Course for Employees in the Container Handling Industry and their revalidation courses). The online learning kit has been uploaded to the homepage of the Labour Department (http://www.labour.gov.hk), and trainees are welcome to browse the site at any time.
