# WORKER STRUCK TO DEATH IN TSEUNG KWAN O

An accident happened in Tseung Kwan O on 26 May 2022, in which a worker was suspected to have been struck by a collapsed metal platform. He was later certified dead in the hospital.

The Construction Industry Council (CIC) would like to deliver this safety message for your attention. It would be much appreciated if you could distribute the message below to your fellow members, relevant personnel or other industry stakeholders where appropriate. Thank you very much.

#### Common Accidents

- 1. Not following proper sequence of dismantling.
- 2. No risk assessment was conducted in the field to identify the relevant potential risks.
- 3. Allow untrained worker to carry out dismantling works.
- 4. No competent person directly supervises dismantling.
- 5. Not using auxiliary equipment to support object to be dismantled.

#### **Critical Control Measures**


- 1. Identify risks, properly plan the procedures, establish system of work and ensure measures were implemented.
- 2. Provide substantive support to the structure to be dismantled.
- 3. Fence off the area for the work.
- 4. Conducted the dismantling work by trained personnel.
- 5. Supervise the dismantling work directly by a competent person.


