Appeal to the Construction Industry to Support COVID-19 Vaccination
Building a Protection Barrier for the Community

HONG KONG • 29 March 2021 - The Construction Industry Council (CIC) and the Hong Kong Construction Association (HKCA) support Food and Health Bureau's announcement today referring to COVID-19 vaccination and regular COVID-19 testing. As receivers should have developed immunity in 14 days after two dosages of COVID-19 vaccine, the Bureau considers those who have completed the COVID-19 vaccination fulfilled the requirement for regular COVID-19 testing. The CIC and HKCA encourage construction industry practitioners to get vaccinated as soon as possible while relevant supporting measures will be arranged soon.

Construction industry practitioners can make their vaccination appointment or enquire through the online booking system of the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme (www.covidvaccine.gov.hk).
