		 a) to build capacity and capability of BIM practitioners through training; b) to increase the awareness and understanding of BIM through promotion; c) to ensure data interoperability and facilitate data sharing through Standards and Guidelines; d) to widen the applications through research and development; and e) to make CIC as the Center of Excellence through industry collaboration
