Personal Information Collection Statement

1. Collection of Personal Data

- The information you provide to the Construction Industry Council, its affiliates, and / or its subsidiaries, including, but not limited to, the Hong Kong Institute of Construction and Zero Carbon Building, Construction Sector Imported Labour Quarters Limited (collectively, the “CIC”), including any personal data as defined in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap.486), will be used solely for purposes related to the activities of the CIC. The activity and the required personal data are detailed in the application form.
- Whether or not you provide your personal data to the CIC is voluntary. However, where you are providing information for the purpose of an application, it is necessary that you supply the CIC with complete information as specified on the application form. Otherwise, the CIC may be unable to process or consider your application. If you are under the age of 18, you should consult your parent or guardian before providing any personal data to us.
- You are entitled to request access to and correction of any errors in your personal data. 2. Purposes of Collection

Your personal data will be kept confidential and may be used by the CIC for the following purposes:

- For purposes related to the worker registration matters pursuant to the Construction Workers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 583), including but not limited to:
 - Assessing your application; and
 - Processing the registration of a construction worker (including preparing his / her registration card) and publish the information (including but not limited to the name, registration number, registration expiry date and information on trade registered) on the [Register of Construction Workers](#) available on the CIC Website for public access.
- Facilitating communication with you;
- Performing and exercising functions and powers of the CIC under relevant legislation, rules and sub-legislation, including but not limited to the Construction Industry Council Ordinance (Cap. 587) and Construction Workers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 583);
- Establishing, exercising and defending the CIC’s legal rights, and complying with the CIC’s legal and regulatory obligations (including anti-money laundering obligations, complying with orders by courts or regulators, etc.);

- e) Managing access to the CIC's premises and for security purposes;
- f) Preventing and responding to actual or potential security threats, fraud or illegal activities;
- g) Handling complaints or enquiries;
- h) Performing analysis and conducting research and surveys;
- i) Performing audits and compliance reviews to ensure compliance with the applicable CIC's policies and procedures, regulations and law;
- j) Other purposes related or incidental to the conduct of the CIC's activities; and
- k) Any other purposes that you may consent to from time to time.

3. Disclosure and Transfer of Personal Data

Guidance Notes on Construction Workers Registration

1. Applicants may apply for Construction Workers Registration through various means. For details, please refer to the CIC website www.cic.hk (Construction Workers Registration - [How to Apply](#)), or scan the QR code on the right-hand side.
 - (1) (Renewal / Information Update) easyJob mobile app
 - (2) (New / Lost or Damaged Card Replacement) e-Form / by post

2. Applicants are required to bring the original application documents for registration in-person at CIC Service Centre. Originals will be returned after checking. Required documents are as follows:
 - (1) A completed and signed "[Application Form for Construction Workers Registration](#)"
 - (2) Identity Document(s)
 - Hong Kong Identity Card
 - "Home Return Permit", or "One Way Exit Permit", or passport/ travel document/ other documents with a valid employment visa relevant to the trade division(s) of the application (applicable to non-Hong Kong permanent residents)
 - Deed Poll (applicable to change of name)
 - (3) Construction Industry Safety Training Certificate (Green Card) (with at least 30 days of validity) ("Green Card" refers to the relevant certificate for completion of a safety course relates to construction work as defined in section 6BA(2) or certificate of exemption for completion of a relevant safety training course as stipulated in section 6BA(4) of the Factories and Industrial Undertakings Ordinance, Cap 59)
 - (4) Qualification documents of related trade divisions and other related documents (with at least 30 days of validity)
 - (5) 1 passport colour photo in white background (applicable to new registration or request for update of photo record) (Requirement: Recent colour passport photo in white background showing full frontal face with clear facial features)
 - (6) The supporting documents required are on a case-by-case basis
3. Applicants may apply for registration as:
 - (1) Registered Skilled Worker for Designated Trade(s)
 - (2) Registered Semi-skilled Worker for Designated Trade(s)
 - (3) Registered General Worker
4. Incomplete information submitted for anyone trade division may render the CIC unable to process the application for this trade division.
5. The registration validity is normally 5 years with a prescribed fee of HK\$100. Only Octopus payment is accepted. If the applicant possesses a qualification which is specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1 of the "Construction Workers Registration Ordinance" (the Ordinance) and is relevant to one of the trade divisions he/she applies to register, he/she is only required to pay a half fee.
6. Application fee will not be transferable once paid. It will not be refunded whether the application is successful or not, or when it is withdrawn halfway.
7. "Expiry Alignment of Workers Registration Card and Green Card" is only applicable to new/renewal registration with more than 18 months validity of Green Card. Applicant is still required to renew the Green Card upon its expiration. Expiry Alignment arrangement is not applicable to the following circumstances:
 - (1) Work in Hong Kong with a working visa
 - (2) Re-issuance of Registration Card for changing or adding trade division(s)
 - (3) Replacement of Registration Card
 - (4) Information update on Registration Card
 - (5) Validity of "Green Card" is less than 18 months
8. The CIC will request the qualification issuing authorities concerned to verify the information provided by the applicants. Should the CIC fail to receive a reply of confirmation of qualification from the authorities concerned after receipt of the application, the CIC will inform the applicants of the possible cancellation of their applications.
9. Information about all the registered trade divisions will be stored as electronic data in the chip embedded inside the Registration Card. However, owing to the limited space available on the back of the card, the registered trade divisions will be printed on it as far as possible, corresponding to the sequence of trades filled in the application form.
10. According to the Ordinance, if a Registered Construction Worker has changed his/her name or address, he/she must give written notice to the Registrar within one month stating the related changes.
11. According to the Ordinance, a person who, without lawful authority or reasonable excuse, sells or offers for sale, lends, gives, hands over or parts with possession to another person a registration card commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine at level 3.
12. If Registered Construction Worker carries out works which are regulated simultaneously by other legislation(s), they shall be conducted in accordance with the relevant statutory requirements apart from the Ordinance.
13. The CIC maintains a Register of Registered Construction Workers on the website www.cic.hk for inspection by the public.
