- Applicants may apply for Construction Workers Registration through various means. For details,
  please refer to the CIC website <a href="www.cic.hk">www.cic.hk</a> (Construction Workers Registration <a href="How to Apply">How to Apply</a>), or scan the QR code on the right-hand side.
- Visiting Service Centre for Workers Registration: Applicants are required to bring the original documents for registration application in-person at the CIC Service Centre. Originals will be returned after checking. Required documents include:
  - (1) Identity Document(s)
    - Hong Kong Permanent Residents Hong Kong Identity Card
    - Non-Hong Kong Permanent Residents -
      - (i) Home Return Permit: Hong Kong Identity Card and Mainland Travel Permits for Hong Kong and Macao
      - (ii) One-way Exit Permit: Hong Kong Identity Card and Permit for Proceeding to Hong Kong and Macao
      - (iii) Doc/I: Hong Kong Identity Card and HKSAR Document of Identity for Visa Purposes
      - (iv) **EEP:** Hong Kong Identity Card and Exit-Entry Permit for Travelling to and from Hong Kong **and Macao** and **Notification Slip for Conditions of Stay**
      - (v) **Working Visa:** Hong Kong Identity Card and passport with a valid employment visa relevant to the trade division(s) of the application

- 3. The registration validity is normally 5 years with a prescribed fee of HK\$100. Payment should be made by octopus or credit card in CIC Service Centre. Applicant possesses a qualification which is specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1 of the Construction Workers Registration Ordinance (CWRO) and is relevant to one of the trade divisions he/she applies to register, he/she is only required to pay half of the prescribed fee. Replacement of a registration card due to loss or damage require an administrative fee of HK\$100.
- 4. Application fee will not be transferable or refundable once paid.
- 5. "Expiry Alignment of Workers Registration Card and Green Card" is only applicable to new/renewal registration with Green Card that has a remaining validity of more than 18 months. Applicant is still required to renew the Green Card upon its expiration. Expiry Alignment arrangement is not applicable under the following circumstances:
  - (1) Work in Hong Kong with a working visa
  - (2) Re-issuance of Registration Card for changing or adding trade division(s)
  - (3) Replacement of Registration Card
  - (4) Information update on Registration Card
  - (5) Remaining validity of Green Card is less than 18 months
- 6. Applicants may apply for registration according to the CWRO as:
  - (1) Registered Skilled Worker for Designated Trade(s)
  - (2) Registered Semi-skilled Worker for Designated Trade(s)
  - (3) Registered General Worker
- 7. Applications will not be processed if incomplete information is submitted by the applicants.
- 8. The Construction Industry Council (CIC) will request the relevant qualification issuing authorities to verify the information provided by the applicants. In the event that qualifications submitted by the applicants fail the verification, the CIC will remove the corresponding qualifications from the applicants' submission.
- 9. Information about all the registered trade divisions will be stored as electronic data in the chip embedded inside the Registration Card. Owing to the limited space at the back of the Registration Card, registered trade divisions will only be printed according to the sequence of trades filled on the application form as far as practicable.
- 10. According to the CWRO, if a Registered Construction Worker has changed his/her name or address, he/she must update the Registrar by using the CIC App or giving written notice within one month.
- 11. If Registered Construction Worker carries out works which are regulated simultaneously by other legislation(s), they shall be conducted in accordance with the relevant statutory requirements apart from the CWRO.
