- The information you provide to the Construction Industry Council, its affiliates, and / or its subsidiaries, including, but not limited to, the Hong Kong Institute of Construction and Zero Carbon Building, Construction Sector Imported Labour Quarters Limited (collectively, the "CIC"), including any personal data as defined in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap.486), will be used solely for purposes related to the activities of the CIC. The activity and the required personal data are detailed in the application form.
- Whether or not you provide your personal data to the CIC is voluntary. However, where you are providing information for the purpose of an application, it is necessary that you supply the CIC with complete information as specified on the application form. Otherwise, the CIC may be unable to process or consider your application. If you are under the age of 18, you should consult your parent or guardian before providing any personal data to us.
- You are entitled to request access to and correction of any errors in your personal data. - Facilitating communication with you;
- Performing and exercising functions and powers of the CIC under relevant legislation, rules and sub-legislation, including but not limited to the Construction Industry Council Ordinance (Cap. 587) and Construction Workers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 583);
- Establishing, exercising and defending the CIC's legal rights, and complying with the CIC's legal and regulatory obligations (including anti-money laundering)

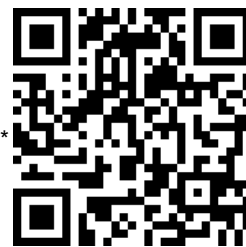

Guidance Notes on Construction Workers Registration

1. Applicants may apply for Construction Workers Registration through various means. For details, please refer to the CIC website www.cic.hk (Construction Workers Registration - [How to Apply](#)), or scan the QR code on the right-hand side.
 - (New / Renewal / Update / Lost Card Replacement) CIC APP / by post

Mark your HKID card copy with the word "COPY" at a place where personal details in the card will not be covered



2. **Visiting Service Centre for Workers Registration:** Applicants are required to bring the original documents for registration application in-person at the CIC Service Centre. Originals will be returned after checking. Required documents include:
 - (1) Identity Document(s)
 - **Hong Kong Permanent Residents** - Hong Kong Identity Card
 - **Non-Hong Kong Permanent Residents** - Hong Kong Identity Card and a "One Way Exit Permit", or a passport/travel document containing a valid visa/ entry permit with a Land Slip/ Notification Slip for Conditions of Stay, together with other relevant documents such as an employment contract, which fulfill the criteria and qualifications for registration
 - **Applicant with change name** - Deed Poll
 - (2) Construction Industry Safety Training Certificate (Construction Industry Green Card)* with a remaining validity of 30 days
* "Construction Industry Green Card" refers to the relevant certificate in section 6BA(2) of the Factories and Industrial Undertakings Ordinance (Cap. 59) in respect of that person's attendance at a safety training course that relates to construction work within the meaning of that Ordinance
 - (3) Qualification documents of related trade divisions and other related documents (with a remaining validity of 30 days)
 - (4) One recent colour passport photo in white background showing full frontal face with clear facial features (applicable to new registration or request for update of photo record)
 - (5) Others as applicable
3. The registration validity is normally 5 years with a prescribed fee of HK\$100. Payment can be made by Octopus, credit card, AlipayHK, WeChat Pay, Apple Pay, Google Pay, BOC Pay, PayMe, or FPS at the CIC Service Centre. Applicant possesses a qualification which is specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1 of the Construction Workers Registration Ordinance (CWRO) and is relevant to one of the trade divisions he/she applies to register, he/she is only required to pay half of the prescribed fee. Replacement of a registration card due to loss or damage require an administrative fee of HK\$100.
4. Application fee will not be transferable or refundable once paid.
5. "Expiry Alignment of Workers Registration Card and Green Card" is only applicable to new/renewal registration with Green Card that has a remaining validity of more than 18 months. Applicant is still required to renew the Green Card upon its expiration. Expiry Alignment arrangement is not applicable under the following circumstances:
 - (1) Work in Hong Kong with a working visa
 - (2) Re-issuance of Registration Card for changing or adding trade division(s)
 - (3) Replacement of Registration Card
 - (4) Information update on Registration Card
 - (5) Remaining validity of Green Card is less than 18 months
6. Applicants may apply for registration according to the CWRO as:
 - (1) Registered Skilled Worker for Designated Trade(s)
 - (2) Registered Semi-skilled Worker for Designated Trade(s)
 - (3) Registered General Worker
7. Applications will not be processed if incomplete information is submitted by the applicants.
8. The Construction Industry Council (CIC) will request the relevant qualification issuing authorities to verify the information provided by the applicants. In the event that qualifications submitted by the applicants fail the verification, the CIC will remove the corresponding qualifications from the applicants' submission.
9. Information about all the registered trade divisions will be stored as electronic data in the chip embedded inside the Registration Card. Owing to the limited space at the back of the Registration Card, registered trade divisions will only be printed according to the sequence of trades filled on the application form as far as practicable.
10. According to the CWRO, if a Registered Construction Worker has changed his/her name or address, he/she must update the Registrar by using the CIC APP or giving written notice within one month.
11. If Registered Construction Worker carries out works which are regulated simultaneously by other legislation(s), they shall be conducted in accordance with the relevant statutory requirements apart from the CWRO.
12. The CIC maintains a Register of Registered Construction Workers on the CIC website www.cic.hk according to the CWRO.
