- (2) Those candidates who failed the written test of the Revalidation course would have one chance to apply for a re-test. If the candidate fails in the re-test, he/she would be required to apply for the 3-day certification training course and tests (including both written and practical tests).
- (3) According to Labour Department guidelines, if you concurrently hold the certification cards for Bulldozer/Loader/Excavator, you can apply for Combined Revalidation and extend the expiry date of the cards.

Candidates who apply for revalidation test, but are unable to attend the test from Monday to Friday for job reasons, can write to our Council to request for attending special classes on Sunday. Such applicants should submit a completed application form attaching a letter signed by the applicant's employer stating the reasons for not able to attend the test from Monday to Friday, and a cheque for the special class fee, for approval by our Council. (Note: the waiting time for the special Sunday classes will be longer than the waiting time for normal Monday to Friday classes).

Proof of Loadshifting Machinery Working Experience

New application : proven record of operating Bulldozer / Loader / Excavator for not less than 3 years before September 2002 ;
 proven record of operating Mini / Skid Loader, Mini / Skid Loader with Attachments(Bulldozer and Excavator) for not less than 1 year before September 2002.
 proven record of operating Compactor for not less than 3 years.

Revalidation : proven record of operating the type of loadshifting machine which you are applying for revalidation for the last 6 consecutive working days as issued by current employer ; or
 proven record of operating the type of loadshifting machine which you are applying for revalidation for not less than 6 months within the last 12 months; or
 proven record of operating the type of loadshifting machine which you are applying for revalidation for not less than 18 months within the last 5 years.

Please be noted that proven record from non-domestic employers / companies is usually not accepted. A proven record recognized by Hong Kong employers / companies or The Hong Kong Construction Industry Professional Plant-operators and Mechanics Association can be accepted as a proof of statement.

New Application:

Applicant for certification test is required to submit a proven record of relevant operation working experience from domestic employers/companies.

Revalidation:

1. Applicant for revalidation test is required to submit a proven record of relevant operation working experience from domestic employers/companies; or
2. A proven record of the required relevant operation work experience issued by The Hong Kong Construction Industry Professional Plant-operators and Mechanics Association or
3. A statutory declaration which issued by the Hong Kong Home Affairs Department as a proof of statement.

Experience in Loadshifting Machinery : Candidates who renew licenses need to report working experience within last 5 years.

Notes for Applicants of Loadshifting Machinery Training Course

- Applicants should complete the proof of working experience in the form.
- The test fees listed may be reviewed and adjusted by the CIC if necessary. Enquiries are welcome.
- Applicants can apply for revalidation 6 months before and within 3 months after the expiry of the certification card. Application for revalidation before the 6-month period will not be entertained, and if after the 3-month period will be treated as new application.
- Applicants should be Hong Kong Permanent Residents of 18 year-old or above. Applicants who are not Hong Kong Permanent Residents, please attach the copy of valid working permit issued by the Hong Kong Immigration Department. For imported worker, job duties approved by relevant government department should also be submitted to verify the worker's necessity to operate the loadshifting machineries concerned.
- Applicants who reach the age of 65, please call CIC Kowloon Bay Campus at 2100 9000 for checking the trades that may be required to submit medical examination reports issued by Registered Medical Practitioners and acquiring the standard forms of reports.
- Candidates may request to postpone the trade test by submitting his reasons in writing. Such letters must reach CIC Kowloon Bay Campus at least 3 working days before the scheduled testing day.
- Application
 - (1) Complete the application form together with a cheque or bank draft for the test fee payable to "**Construction Industry Council**".
 - (2) A photo copy of the applicant's Hong Kong ID Card must be submitted with the application form. After the test, the copy will be destroyed according to the CIC procedures.
 - (3) Applicants of Revalidation Test should submit copy of certification card. If the current certification card held by the applicant was not issued by CIC, applicants must fill in the "Personal Claim" and submit together with the application. **Applicants must bring their old / current certification card to the course/test for verification. Those who fail to present their card will not be allowed to attend the course/test.**
 - (4) end the application form with a copy of the HKID card and the cheque to the **CIC 38/F, COS Centre, 56 Tsun Yip Street, Kwun Tong, Kowloon**.
 - (5) Candidates who want to withdraw from the tests have to submit their reasons in writing to the CIC Kowloon Bay Campus at least 3 working days before the schedule test date. Once the withdrawal request is approved, the fees paid will be refunded after charging an administration fee amounting to 20% of the total. Special consideration will be given to candidates who request to withdraw because of prolonged injury.

Personal Information Collection Statement

1. Collection of Personal Data

- 1.1. Hong Kong Institute of Construction (“HKIC”) is one of the member organizations of the Construction Industry Council (the “CIC”). - 1.2. Whether or not you provide your personal data to HKIC is voluntary. However, where you are providing information for the purpose of an application, it is necessary that you supply HKIC with complete information as specified on the application form. Otherwise, HKIC may be unable to process or consider your application. If you are under the age of 18, you should consult your parent or guardian before providing any personal data to us.
- 1.3. You are entitled to request access to and correction of any errors in your personal data. 2. Purposes of Collection
