Sub-contractor Cooperative Training Scheme Recruitment Day

Hong Kong • 26 February 2015 – The “Sub-contractor Cooperative Training Scheme Recruitment Day” is jointly organized by the Construction Industry Council and Hong Kong Construction Sub-Contractors Association to recruit new entrants on “First-hire-then-train” basis. During the on-site training period, trainees can receive \$10,000 monthly allowance and salary at maximum. More than 100 job vacancies of building construction trades are offered. The trade associations will set up recruitment counters and conduct selection interview instantly.

The Recruitment Day will be held on 28 February (Saturday) 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Construction Industry Resource Centre, 44 Tai Yip Street, Kowloon Bay. The job vacancies comprise the following trades: Concretor, Plasterer, Bricklayer, Tiler, Marble Worker, Painter, Tower Crane Erecting & Dismantling Worker, Carpenter as well as Bar Bender and Fixer.

Successful applicants will receive fundamental skill training before attending on-site training. Upon passing at the Intermediate Trade Test, the candidate can register as semi-skilled worker and be employed by the sub-contractors. After several years of relevant working experience, he could take the trade test for craftsmen passing which can then register as skilled worker. Candidate can consider taking up the roles of trade supervisor or attending designated training courses to become a technically competent person (T1) which is recognised by the Building Department. The current daily wage of the skilled workers of the above-mentioned trades is in the range of \$1,000 to \$1,800. A competitive salary may be offered for those with outstanding performance.
