Sham Shui Po Job Fair in Construction Industry

Hong Kong • 1 November 2013 – A total of 16 building contractors and construction related companies will take part in Sham Shui Po Job Fair this Sunday (3 November) at Dragon Centre to attract more new blood to join the industry. More than 400 job vacancies are offered where the monthly salary will start from \$10,000. Mr Matthew CHEUNG Kin-chung, GBS, JP, Secretary for Labour and Welfare will officiate at the opening ceremony at 11:30am. Other guests will include Mr. WAI Chi-sing, JP, Permanent Secretary for Development (Works), Honourable Starry LEE Wai-king, JP, Member of the Legislative Council and Executive Council, and Dr the Honourable CHIANG Lai-wan, JP, Member of Legislative Council.

The event is coorganized by the Hong Kong General Building Contractors Association, the Construction Industry Council (CIC) and the Democratic Alliance for the Betterment and Progress of Hong Kong Sham Shui Po Office. This event does not only provide a good number of construction-industry job opportunities for residents, but also provide a channel for employers to recruit suitable manpower. Vacancies for either skilled or non-skilled workers in a wide range of construction trades, including civil, electrical and mechanical works will be offered.

Other contents in the job fair include display of construction vacancies information by Jobsnet Kiosk, contractors cooperative training scheme details, and recruitment booth by CIC. The event is not only suitable for job seekers but also for young adults who would like to receive training and then join the construction industry.
