# <u>Construction Industry Council Extends the Waiver of</u> Construction Workers Registration and Renewal Fees

**Hong Kong** • **24 September 2020** – In response to the relief measures announced by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region on 15 September 2020 which included the rental concessions and fee waivers, the Construction Industry Council (CIC) will extend the waiver of the construction workers registration and renewal fees for another period of 12 months from 1 October 2020 to 30 September 2021.

This fee waiver measure aims to alleviate the financial burden of frontline construction workers and is expected to benefit about 110,000 construction workers, costing around HK\$9 million. Together with the waiver implemented on 1 October 2019, the CIC will waive the relevant fees for construction workers for 2 years in total with a sum of approx. HK\$19 million.

The registration of construction workers is valid for a 5-year term. Workers can renew their registration 6 months before the expiry of their current term.
