DfMA MiMEP Tradeshow 2021 Successfully Concluded

Hong Kong • 22 March 2021 – The DfMA MiMEP Tradeshow 2021 (the Tradeshow) was successfully concluded on 12 March 2021. Jointly co-organised by the Construction Industry Council (CIC) and The Hong Kong Federation of Electrical and Mechanical Contractors (HKFEMC) (the Organisers), the Tradeshow ran from 2 to 12 March 2021 at the CIC-Zero Carbon Park (CIC-ZCP). It showcased the industry's capability in DfMA - MultiTrade integrated Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing (MiMEP) works. With 25 innovative and inspirational exhibits, over 3,300 project clients, industry practitioners and government regulators were attracted to visit the Tradeshow.

Along with the Tradeshow, a conference and a technical forum were organised. 15 industry experts from project clients, practitioners, specialist contractors, and professional bodies shared their knowhow and experience in adopting DfMA - MiMEP works at these events. Close to 3,000 participants, in person at the CIC-ZCP and online, attended the conference and the forum.
