Hong Kong • 19 September 2021 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) today held the "Construction Industry Council Basketball Competition 2021" (Competition) at HKIC – Sheung Shui Campus. Ms. Winnie HO, Director of Architectural Services, was invited as the Guest of Honour for the Award Presentation Ceremony. This year, 20 basketball teams from the construction industry took part and demonstrated outstanding performance at this annual competition.

The "Construction Industry Council Basketball Competition" was launched by the Construction Industry Sports and Volunteering Programme (CISVP) under the CIC in 2017 to promote healthy lifestyle and athletic sense among the industry practitioners.
