Outstanding Students Awarded Scholarship for Family Members of Registered Construction Workers

Hong Kong • 2 November 2021 - The Construction Industry Council (CIC) organised the 11th award ceremony for the Scholarship for Family Members of Registered Construction Workers (Scholarship) on 30 October. Stakeholders of construction industry were invited for the first time to participate in this signature event through sponsorship to signify their commitment to corporate social responsibility. Eight Registered Specialist Trade Contractors and construction companies showed their support. A record high of total 39 awards with over HK\$300,000 scholarships were awarded to the families of construction workers who achieved outstanding results in the 2021 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination.

Mr. CHAN Ka-kui, Chairman of the CIC, in his sharing with awarded students said, "Hong Kong has majestic skyscrapers and world-class infrastructure, which are attributed to tireless efforts of our outstanding talents. The competence of Hong Kong's construction practitioners is beyond any doubt, especially the frontline workers. Children of construction workers should be proud of their parents. The vibrant development of the Mainland China in the past fifty years provides ample opportunities for the new generation, especially in the Greater Bay Area." Mr. CHAN further encouraged students to get to know history and make judgement with wisdom.

Ir Kenneth MO, Chairperson of the Construction Workers Registration Board congratulated the awarded students in his speech, and encouraged them to pursue for knowledge and be thankful to their parents. He hoped that students would become professionals applying knowledge and skills learnt to drive construction and economic development of Hong Kong upon graduation.

The CIC established the Scholarship in 2011 to commend the immediate family members of registered construction workers for their outstanding academic performance and to recognise construction workers who have contributed to the development of a sustainable Hong Kong while nurturing the next generation of talent. The Scholarship consists of "Open Category" and "Construction Related Curricula Category". The latter aims at encouraging more graduates to join the construction industry to construct Hong Kong.
