Construction Industry Happy Run 2023 - Enjoy Fun of Sports

Hong Kong • 8 January 2023 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) held the "Construction Industry Happy Run 2023" Physical Run today at HKIC - Tai Po Training Ground. Mr. LAU Chun-kit, Ricky, Permanent Secretary for Development (Works) of Development Bureau was invited as the Guest of Honour for the Award Presentation Ceremony. Nearly 1,500 runners from around 100 organisations have taken part in the long-distance running event.

The "Construction Industry Happy Run 2023" includes the Pre-event Virtual Run and the Physical Run. The Pre-event Virtual Run lasted for one and a half months and concluded successfully last month, the champion ran for 1,178 kilometer in total. Physical Run was once again held after 3 years and comprises a 10K race and a 3.5K happy run. Races were started and finished at HKIC - Tai Po Training Ground, and the route bypassed Tai Po Waterfront Park. Apart from individual awards for men and women categories, team races 'Parent-and-Child Race' and 'Construction Style Relay' were also held to encourage more families and colleagues from the construction industry to participate in. Development Bureau has won both the 'Perseverant Organisation Award" and "Team Spirit Award'.

To let everyone to enjoy in the event, runners are welcome to invite their family and friends to join the carnival, activities include various game booths, rhythmic gymnastics performances, and food & beverage was offered as well.

Construction Industry Council has established the 'CIC Youth Affairs Committee' (CICYAC) in 2022, which aims to develop the future direction of the youth development policy. CICYAC held the first 'Fun Run' to raise fund for the 'Construction Industry Greater Bay Area Youth Internship Programme', with tremendous support from leaders of the construction industry, over 200 thousand Hong Kong dollars were raised.
