Construction Industry Sports Day and Charity Fun Day 2023 <u>Unites 1,000 Athletes and Families</u> Construction Industry Caring Charity Run Raises \$100,000

Hong Kong • 26 November 2023 – After four years hiatus, the "Construction Industry Sports Day and Charity Fun Day" (Sports Day) held today at the Tai Po Sports Ground. Ms. Clarice YU, Director of Buildings, and Mr. Ricky LAU, Permanent Secretary for Development (Works), were invited as the Guests of Honour for the Opening Ceremony and the Closing Ceremony respectively. Nearly 1,000 athletes from more than 30 organisations enthusiastically participated in the sports day.

The Sports Day has consistently garnered tremendous support and active participation from the industry, bringing together various sports elites to compete on the field. Alongside the track and field events for both men and women, the Sports Day introduced a "Workers Category" in relay events, 100m sprints, and Fun Obstacles Family Challenge Races, encouraging the active involvement of construction workers. One of the highlights was the "Workers Cup 4x100m relay" where registered construction workers from different trades competed in relay races and the audience fervently cheered them on. The event also featured a carnival with various booths offering construction and sports-themed games, as well as food and beverage stalls, ensuring the participants and their families enjoy a delightful day.

The "Construction Industry Caring Charity Run" remained a significant highlight of the Sports Day each year. Philanthropic individuals from the construction industry wholeheartedly contributed, both financially and physically, by participating in the 400m run. This year, a total of HK\$100,000 was raised, which will be donated to the "Construction Charity Fund" and the "Construction Charity Fund Integrated Service Centre", providing valuable assistance to individuals and families in need within the industry.
