# The CIC's Construction Workers Professional Development Scheme Award Ceremony Successfully Concludes

**Hong Kong • 26 June 2024 -** The Construction Industry Council (CIC) organised an Award Ceremony of Construction Workers Professional Development Scheme (Development Scheme) on 23 June 2024, to recognise the outstanding achievements of the workers who have promoted to Registered Skilled Workers or Registered Semi-skilled Workers. The CIC also presented "Craftsman Family" and "Craftsman Company" awards to acknowledge multigenerational family members of the craftsmen, and to recognise the support provided by employers towards their workers, exemplifying the spirit of solidarity and unity within the construction industry.

Ir Prof. Thomas HO, Chairman of the CIC, shared the latest industry developments and safety culture with the awardees during the ceremony. He introduced the Smart Site Safety System (4S) and reminded workers to immediately stop their work and reassess risks whenever there were changes in the circumstances.
