Construction Industry 5-a-side Football Competition 2024 Construction Industry Caring Cup Raises HK\$220,000

Hong Kong • 4 August 2024 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) today held the "Construction Industry 5-a-side Football Competition 2024" at Hong Kong Football Club. Mr. Ricky LAU, Permanent Secretary for Development (Works), was invited as the Guest of Honour for the award presentation ceremony. Over 60 football teams from the construction industry took part and demonstrated outstanding performance at this annual competition.

Launched by the Construction Industry Sports and Volunteering Programme (CISVP) under the CIC in 2019, the "Construction Industry 5-a-side Football Competition" promotes a healthy lifestyle and sports culture among industry practitioners. The competition has received overwhelming responses from the industry, and this year, around 120 exciting matches were played in total. In the Men's Cup Final, Welcome Construction Company Limited seized the championship after a tense game against VSL-Intrafor. While in the Women's Final, ASD Female Football Team defeated PSB Phoenix Football Team to crown the champion. The event also featured a carnival with various booths offering sports-themed games, food and beverage stalls, and a photo zone, bringing joy to participants and their families.

The "Construction Industry Caring Cup" remained a significant highlight of the 5-a-side football competition this year, with a team from the Development Bureau played against the "Construction Industry Team". A total of HK\$220,000 were raised and will be donated to the "Construction Charity & Caring Centre", which provides support to the family members of workers affected by construction incidents.
