Hong Kong • 18 September 2022 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) today held the "Construction Industry Basketball League 2022" Finals (Competition) at HKIC – Sheung Shui Campus. This year, 20 basketball teams from the construction industry took part and demonstrated outstanding performance at this annual competition.
